

COVID-19 UPDATE

As of Monday, March 16, 2020, **VILLA PARK - Parks and Recreation (VPPR)** has cancelled all programs, events and rentals through April 5, 2020, with the exception of the **Funtime Junction** daycare. Participants will be refunded or credited for any cancelled programs, rentals, and events. The Community Recreation Building (CRB) at 320 E. Wildwood is closed to public. However, it will remain a polling place for the Illinois Primary election on March 17, 2020.

Currently, there have been **NO** confirmed COVID-19 cases in any **VPPR** programs, events or facilities. Staff is exercising an abundance of caution and have based decisions on recommendations from public health officials to minimize exposure to participants and staff and to limit the spread of the virus while reducing strain on the healthcare system. While programs will be cancelled, VPPR will continue to operate and staff will be available via phone and email during normal business hours, Monday – Friday, 9 am to 5 pm.

The Village is monitoring the status of the overall progression of COVID-19 in the State of Illinois and particularly in DuPage County. In addition, the Village is following the protocols set forth by Governor Pritzker along with recommendations and information provided by: the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).
