While **VILLA PARK – Parks and Recreation** remains COVID -19 free, the pandemic is spiking in DuPage County.

Due to the rise in the number of COVID-19 cases and in order to reduce the risk of community spread, Villa Park Village President Bulthuis has directed that all Villa Park public buildings except those providing essential services, be closed to the public until further notice effective November 17, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. The Community Recreation Building (320 E. Wildwood) is closed. **Funtime Junction Daycare and Preschool** will remain in session at the Iowa Community Center; however, all other programs are being postponed.

This decision is due in part to the DuPage County statistics which are currently above the daily positivity rate of 15 % with a 7-day average over 14.6%. (<https://dph.illinois.gov/covid19/covid19-statistics>) The Village asks for your patience as we continue navigate the novel COVID-19 virus.
